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24SUMMERTIPS for a cool home and green neighbourhood

Live in a cool and healthy home

Block out heat with sun protection



Sunlight on glass causes heat; shade brings coolness. Use awnings, shutters or screens. Shade cloths or parasols work too.

Keep windows and doors closed during hot days



Keep your house closed during hot weather to trap cool air. Shut curtains for extra insulation.

Make windows resistant to sun and heat



Install reflective film on blinds or windows. This is affordable and works for both heat and cold.

Only open windows and doors when it cools down



Open windows and doors during cool evenings and mornings to let fresh air in.

Insulate your walls, roof. and windows



Bio-based insulation keeps heat out and cool in. You'll still need sun protection for windows in direct sunlight.

Ventilate well for healthy indoor air



Ventilate for at least an hour a day, especially using vents or top windows not in direct sunlight.

Green your home, roof, garden or balcony

Replace garden tiles with greenery



Swap tiles for greenery. Plant shrubs instead-rainwater will be absorbed into the soil and promotes biodiversity.

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Add more green with a hedge, shrub or tree



Add climbing plants or a hedge to shared fences with neighbours.

Help insects with native plants



Support local insects. Choose native, pesticide-free flowers—ask your garden centre.

Make your garden animal-friendly



Create homes for bees and other creatures. Use insect hotels, nesting boxes, bushes, log piles, hedges, and patches of bare earth.

Create a green wall or roof garden for cooling



Green roofs and walls can lower temperatures by around 7°C. Apply for a façade garden via www. middelburg.nl/ geveltuintje-

No garden? Green your balcony



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Use pots, crates, stacked pallets, or vertical garden containers.

Save energy, also in the summer

Use a fan, not an air conditioner



Fans use much less energy and contain no harmful substances.

Line dry laundry, don't use a dryer



Line-drying saves electricity. Even drying half of your laundry this way saves money and energy.
